Why the RPG Bus & Trailers

- Evolution of issues leading to trying to find solutions.
- Game stores noisy, dirty, uncomfortable, need high population density to stay in business, inaccessible, temperature, smells, etc.
- Rehabilitation & medical facilities, difficulty booking space for more than 45-60 minutes, noise, space for groups in wheelchairs
- Sain Luke's rehab the catalyst in 2013

Research & Evolution

- Researched for 2 years.
- First trailer destroyed
- Second trailer less than ideal
- Third trailer great
- Bus nice but limited space and lift vs. ramp
- Insurance far more for bus than trailers

Started Accessibility, now much more

- RPG Parties
- Long road trips staff
- RPG & Accessbility advocacy
- Mobile broadcast spaces
- Even during COVID, safe spaces for one-on-one for those in half-way houses and others with no private space

Expands reach to those that need it the most

- Those needed services in under-served, and especially un-served areas, such as low population density or even remote rural locations.
- Providing services where nobody else does.
- Can control all sensory stimuli, colors, noise, temperature, lighting, smells, etc.

Outdoor Events

- MDA Camp
- Toilets, showers, exterior showers
- Support weekend events where no other services
- Can turn "fleet" into square with courtyard between for even more usable space


RPG Tours

- Raises awareness
- Very expensive for gas (6 MPG), but keeps other costs down
- Bring accessibility equipment to entire conventions lacking
